The Board of Director's has defined preferred locations for satellite dish installations at all Single Family style one-story homes as follows:

- In the rear of the home at either corner of the screened cage but within property lines, ground mounted and screened from view of other Units with hedge plantings.
- In the back grassy area between the screened cage and the planted bed which defines the property line, ground mounted and screened from view of other Units with hedge plantings.
- In the rear planted bed which defines the property line, ground mounted and screened from view of other Units with hedge plantings.

For two story Town Homes style homes, the preferred locations are as follows:

- Within the patio area, ground mounted and screened from view of other Units with potted plants or other acceptable screen, or
- Within the garage bed, ground mounted and screened from view of other Units with hedge plantings.

Preferred locations have been defined with the goal of preserving the aesthetic beauty of VillageWalk of Bonita Springs, therefore it is preferred that satellite dishes not be attached in the front areas of the home nor to the exterior structure of the home whenever possible if signal reception will not be impaired. If location of the dish will not be in a Board Preferred Location, a letter from the installing dish company must accompany the Installation Notification stating the reason the dish was installed in an alternate location.
